A spa paradise in the heart of Europe

The Karlovy Vary Region is the pulsing heart of the European spa industry. People from around the world come here to rest, to improve their health, and to eliminate stress or lifestyle diseases. The famous spa towns with their romantic atmosphere offer healing and centuries-proven therapeutic procedures and modern medicine, as well as cultural events and enchanting nature. You can choose one of the five picturesque spa towns surrounded by nature, which urge one to do sports and to explore. Karlovy Vary, Františkovy Lázně, Mariánské Lázně, Jáchymov, and Lázně Kynžvart await your visit.

The therapeutic landscape

The surroundings of the spa towns were created with respect to nature as a therapeutic landscape for the needs of patients. The unique combination of therapeutic procedures that use the natural curative resources (mineral springs, natural gases, peat, peloids, and radon water) is fittingly complemented by social activities, physical training, sports, or walks in the spa parks and forests. The Karlovy Vary Region, especially the area of the Slavkovský Forest, can boast of exceptional climatic conditions. The local constant and elevated level of humidity is given by the proximity of mixed coniferous forests, which produce slightly negative ions, and the ideally pristine atmosphere with a minimum amount of sulphur oxides, nitrogen, and particulate matter, and thus has exceptionally positive effects on respiratory system diseases.

THE SPA TRIANGLE ON THE UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE LIST



Together, Karlovy Vary, Mariánské Lázně, and Františkovy Lázně create the famous spa triangle, where the greatest concentration of curative springs with unique therapeutic qualities is located. To this day, the towns have preserved the authentic appearance that these spa resorts had up to the mid-20th century. Their wonderfully preserved architecture reflects the international spa trend preferring the Classicist and Historicism styles. The tradition of the spa treatment in the Karlovy Vary Region dates back to the 14th century. Thanks to the natural therapeutic procedures, the holistic approach to health, the unique architecture, and the varied social life, our spa towns rightfully rank among the significant European cultural centres.

Along with other European spa towns, the spa triangle of Karlovy Vary, Mariánské Lázně, and Františkovy Lázně was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List as a part of the transnational series “The Great Spa Towns of Europe”.

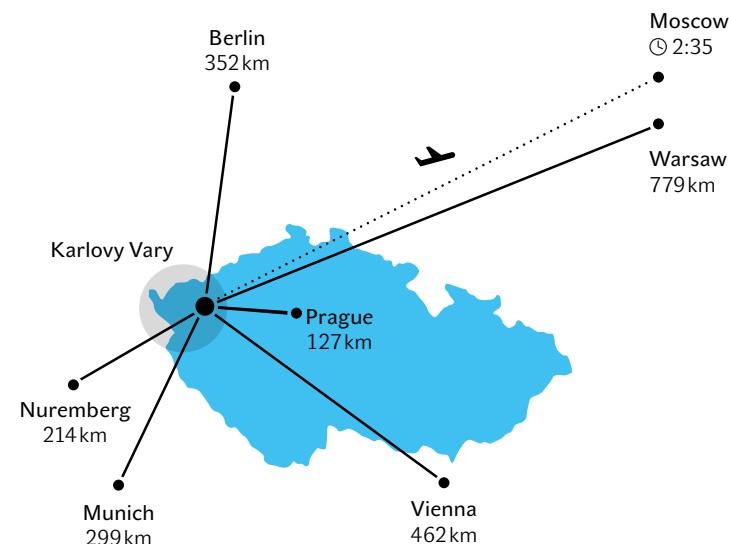

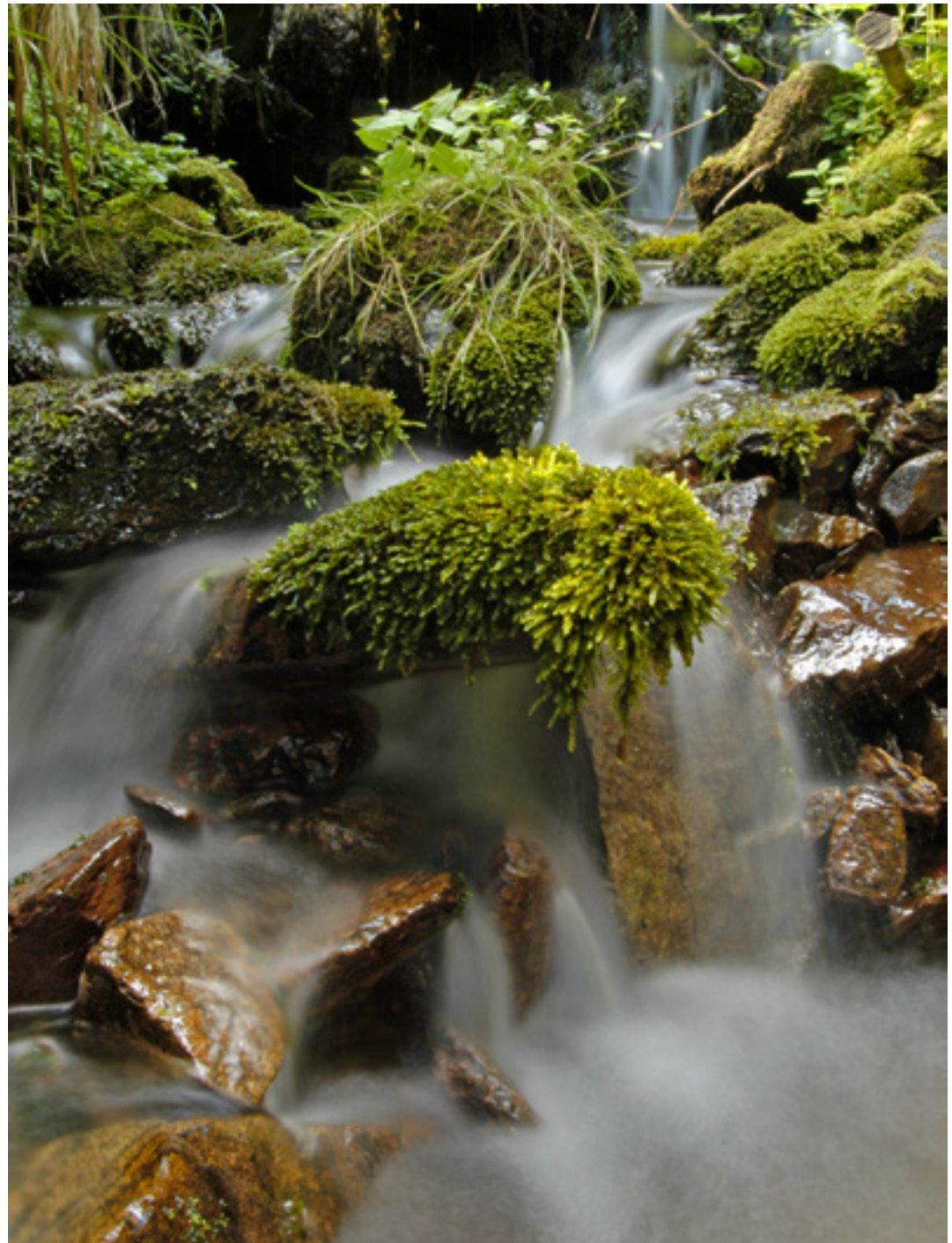

The therapeutic power of nature

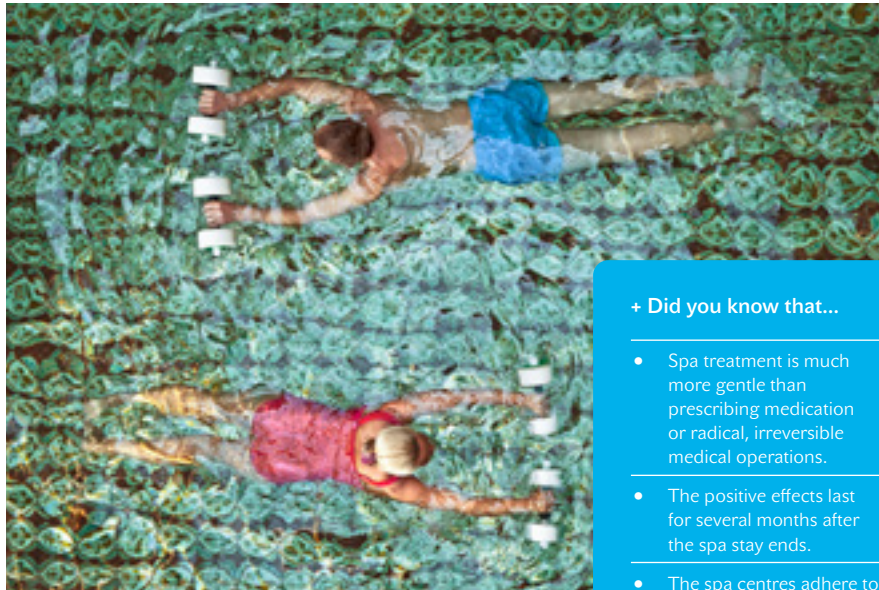

Just as vital are the climate conditions that are characterised by clean air and the significant concentration of healing essences and turpentine, which underscores the excellent medical results of the spas here. Radon water, which literally has miraculous effects that are repeatedly sought-out by patients from around the world who desire this life-saving pain relief, sources from the depths of the rugged Ore Mountain wilderness.

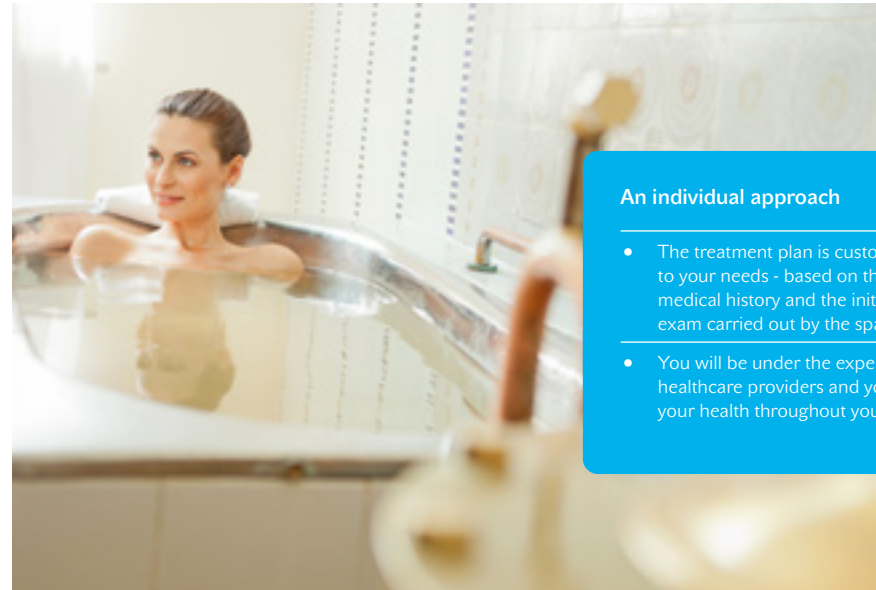

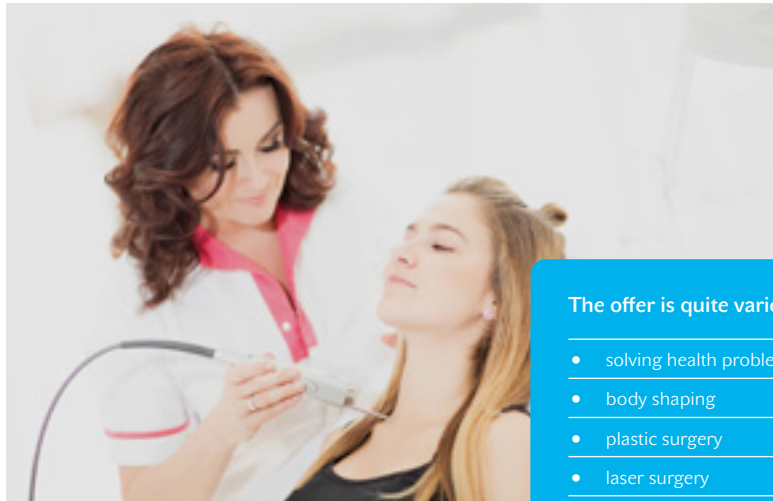

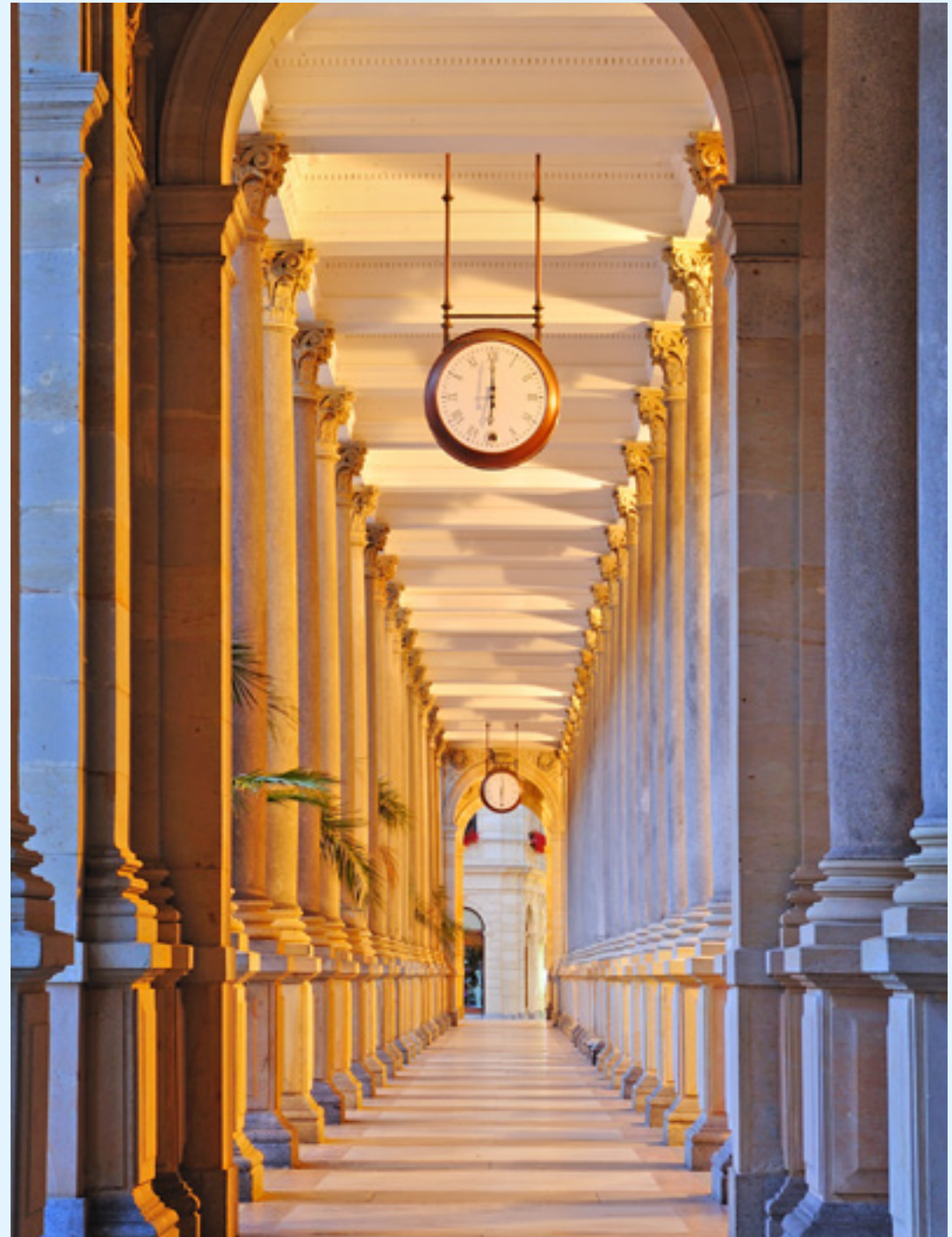
KARLOVY VARY

- This famous town was founded in the 14th century by the emperor and king Charles IV.
- The spa can boast of having the largest number of curative thermal springs worldwide.
- The warmest thermal spring is the Hot Spring (73.4 °C), which jets to heights of up to 12 m.
- The unique spa architecture and the extensive municipal parks are complemented by a holistic approach to health.
- Karlovy Vary was loved by an entire range of famous guests, such as Johann Wolfgang Goethe, Ludwig van Beethoven, or Antonín Dvořák, and many more.

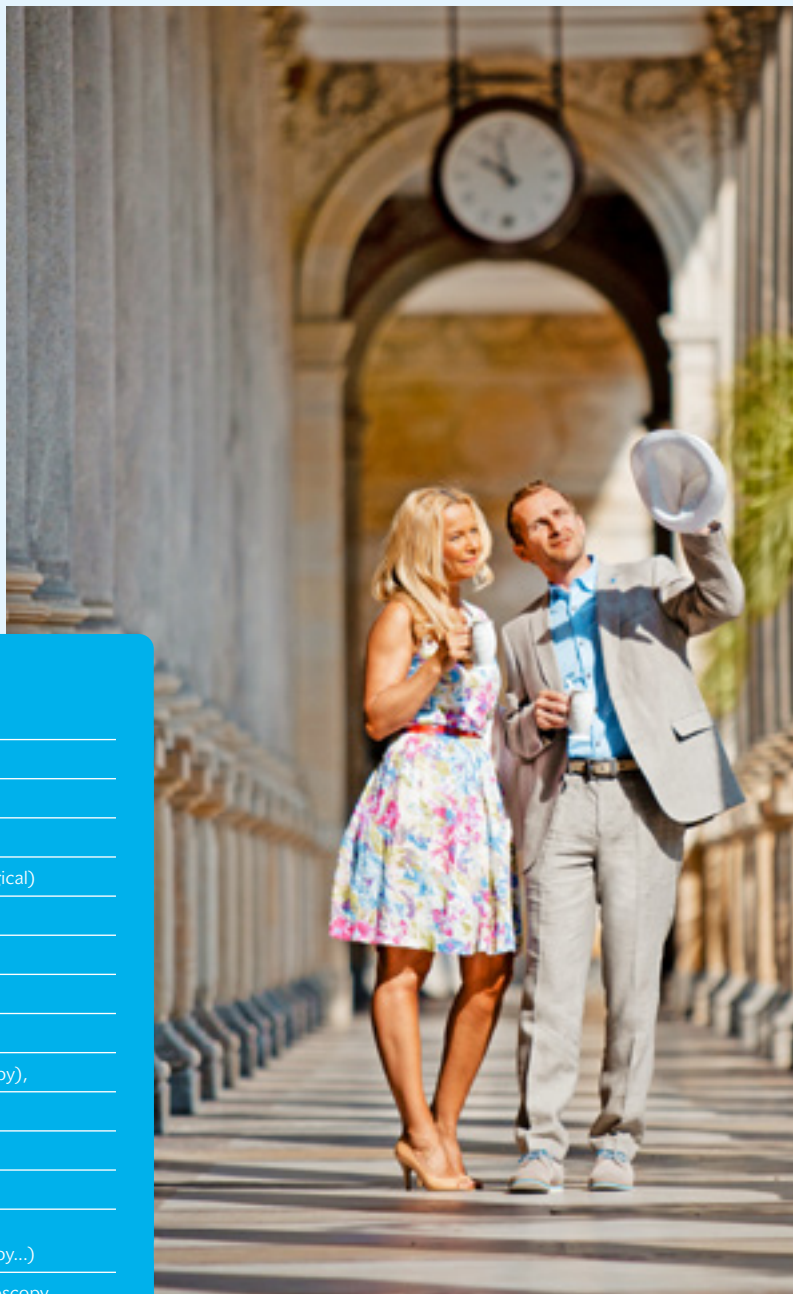

- More than forty mineral springs source in the town and its proximity, as well as more than 160 sources of ferrous acidulous mineral water containing carbon dioxide and mineral salts, with an average temperature of 7–10 °C.
- The “Maria Gas Lake” – a unique procedure – utilises natural CO₂, the so-called Maria Gas.
- The dominant of the town is the Singing Fountain along with the splendid Main Colonnade.
- Some of the most significant guests of Mariánské Lázně were J. W. Goethe, English king Edward VII, or Franz Kafka.
- Significant social events are held in Mariánské Lázně each year, such as the Chopin Festival or the Marienbad Film Festival.



Therapeutic processes

Therapeutic resources, such as cold hypotonic acidulous waters used for treatments including drinking cures, inhalations, and for preparing carbon and mineral baths, peat, peloids, and Maria Gas, and even the exceptional submontane climate are used for treatment. The primary treatment methods in Mariánské Lázně are: the drinking cure, treatments using mineral baths, dry carbon baths, gas injections, and peat packs. But also hydrotherapy, electrotherapy, and inhalations, oxygen therapy, or physical therapy using remedial exercises. Six springs are primarily used for the drinking cure: Cross, Rudolf, Karolina, Forest, Ambrose, and Ferdinand. Treatment focuses on diseases of the kidneys and the urinary tract, the locomotor system, the digestive system, but also of neurological problems and states following cancer treatment (remissions).

The unique-worldwide beneficial gas known as Maria Gas

However, the absolute rarity is the procedure known as the Maria Gas Lake, in which the spa guests absorb CO₂ directly from the Spring. Maria Gas is also used in the dry carbon baths and for gas injections. This results in the improved regeneration of the cells and the slowing down of ageing. You cannot try this procedure anywhere but here.

"The drinking cure is a complex process, and it is always necessary to keep in mind that a certain spring is suitable for specific problems and can be highly inappropriate for others. It is always necessary to consult your drinking cure with a physician, since an improperly applied drinking cure can do harm."

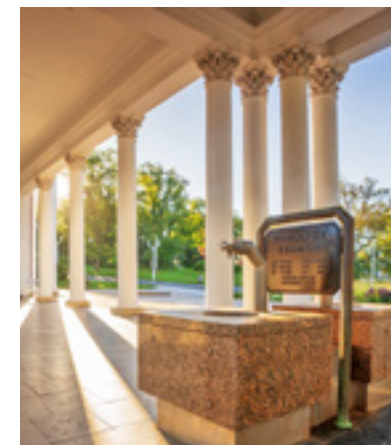

Did you know that...

- The town is named after Emperor Franz I, who established it in 1793. It is the first peat bog spa in the world.
- The smallest town of the Western Bohemia spa triangle has a typical chessboard layout, in which blocks of houses alternate with extensive parks.
- Exceptional mineral springs rich in Glauber salts and carbon dioxide source in the town and its surroundings. There are large deposits of valuable sulphuric-ferrous peat here.
- Františkovy Lázně was loved by, for instance, J. W. Goethe, Prince Metternich, Johann Strauss, and several other significant figures and members of the European aristocracy.
- Legend has it that every woman who touches the left leg of the statue of the little boy František will become pregnant.
- Spa guests, just as families with children, take advantage of the Aquaforum – the largest and most beautiful water park of Czech spas – to a great extent.
- The town was awarded the title of the Most Beautiful Historical Town of the Czech Republic.



Treatment of pain and infertility

The sulphuric-ferrous peat from the local fens, also known as black gold, alleviates pain resulting from arthritis or rheumatism, and helps treat gynaecological diseases. It is used in the form of packs and baths and is complemented by many modern therapeutic procedures. The local mineral springs are used hand in hand with the peat, and are excellently suited for baths, but also for drinking cures or inhalations. Natural carbon dioxide gas is gained from the dry sources of the mineral springs and is an effective helper in the treatment of cardiovascular diseases or of headaches and backaches. It is not only because of the valuable natural resources, but also because of the pleasant environment that calms the body and mind that makes Františkovy Lázně legendary for treating infertility, which is to be symbolically driven away by the statue of little František with the fish.

What is used for treatment here?

The natural resources in Františkovy Lázně are the local sulphuric-ferrous peat, mineral water, and curative gas.

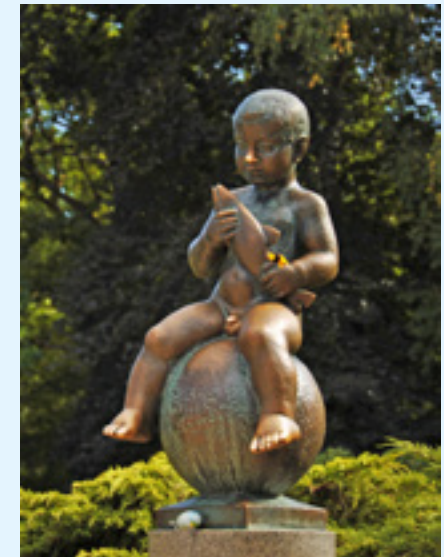

JÁCHYMOV

The town where the history of the Atomic Age began, as well as that of radon spa treatment. To this day, Jáchymov, where Marie Curie discovered radium in the local pitchblende, has maintained the genius loci of its heyday, when the first radon spa was established and people from around the world travelled here for treatment.

Did you know that...

- The mining landscape of Jáchymov is inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site list. Jáchymov, which was first made famous for mining silver and later uranium, is one of the cradles of the mining industry.
- In 1898, Marie Curie-Skłodowska discovered the new element of radium in the pitchblende of Jáchymov.
- Unique radon water, the basis for the local treatment, is drawn from the oldest still-functioning mine in Europe - the Svornost Mine.
- The unique therapeutic method called radium brachytherapy - the controlled application of gamma rays directly to the sites of pain - helps relieve chronic pain.
- Radon baths are a traditional treatment for the general ailments associated with ageing (antiaging treatments), since they strongly counter the body's oxidation stress caused by the environment.
- Jáchymov is located on the edge of the Ore Mountain range, which offer activities year-round.



Radon water for pain relief

Treatment in the Jáchymov spa combines the rare radon water with the professional approach of healthcare workers trained to effectively use it. It is complemented by the offer of high-quality services in the spa buildings, located in the pristine environment of the Ore Mountains. Radon baths have beneficial effects on the human body since low doses of radiation in the form of radon baths stimulate the cells and their self-healing processes. The result is a strong anti-inflammatory effect. Aside from the pain relief itself, radon therapy brings distinct relief for chronic locomotor diseases of a rheumatoid, neurological, and orthopaedic origin, but also of common back pain. The fame of the baths in Jáchymov and their high effectiveness helps rank the spa here among the top spas in the Czech Republic, in Europe, and even worldwide.

From the doctors’ perspective

The unique Jáchymov treatment

“The spa in Jáchymov was established in 1906 as the first radon spa in the world. The unique radon water effectively helps treat diseases of the locomotor system. No other European spa has such a high concentration of radon in the natural mineral water as Jáchymov. Thanks to this, our spa is the most effective radon spa in Europe. The basis of effective spa treatment in Jáchymov is the combination of unique radon water baths with first-rate rehabilitation. Based on the initial physical examination, the spa physician will prescribe the most suitable procedures using the curative radon water, rehabilitation, and physical therapy. The expertly managed spa treatment reduces the need of medicated treatment and improves the quality of life for a period of up to 8-10 months. To achieve the maximum treatment effect, it is recommended that one take twenty-four radon baths per year.”

Lázně Kynžvart primarily specialises in the treatment of the respiratory system or of dermatological problems in children aged two to fifteen years, and in the case of kidney disease or obesity, up to nineteen years of age. School education is ensured during their stays.

Just breathe

Thanks to its specific climatic conditions, Lázně Kynžvart is labelled as the most significant spa site in the Czech Republic. It ranks among the four spa facilities in the Czech Republic that abound in high-quality and stable climatic conditions. Therefore, the Czech Ministry of Health has declared these climatic conditions as a natural healing resource.

Mineral Springs

The Kynžvart mineral springs, which are a part of the thermal network of acidulous mineral waters within the Mariánské Lázně spring area, are used for the treatment. However, the only thing they have in common with the Mariánské Lázně springs is the underground source of carbon dioxide. Presently, four springs are collected - Helena, Viktor, Marie, and Richard. High-quality peat from the Třeboň region is used for treatment.

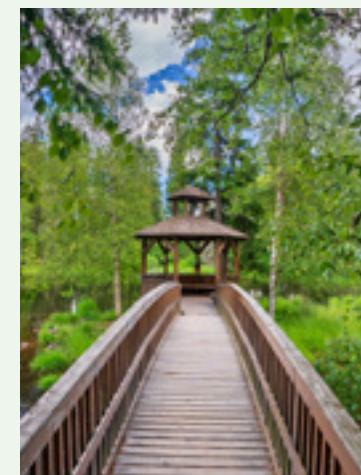
